MUMBAI: Farukh Khaliluddin and Thomas Uledhar were caught at the wrong place at the wrong time--one at CST and the other at Cama hospital during the 26/11 attacks. On Monday, besides other evidence, the Bombay high court, based on the duo's evidence, concluded that [Ajmal Kasab](#) deserved the death sentence for his "depravity and the pleasure he took in killing innocent people".

Khaliluddin was waiting with his son at CST to board a train to Jalgaon after meeting a relative who was to go for the Haj. He told the trial court that around 10 pm there was an explosion and he saw two "young boys" firing indiscriminately at waiting passengers. The taller of the two threw a grenade towards them and both he and his son were badly injured. The shorter fired at the passengers "in a joyous mood". Khaliluddin, who still has grenade particles lodged in his body, identified Kasab as the person who was firing. "It is evident that Kasab took perverse pleasure in killing innocent people," observed a division bench of Justices Ranjana Desai and Ranjit More.

Uledhar had come to see his sister at Cama on the night of November 26, 2008. He testified that two men had found them in the hospital's corridor and forced them against the wall along with some others. The taller man stabbed and shot an elderly person, while the shorter one had snatched their mobile phones. The duo then locked them in a bathroom. Uledhar identified Kasab in court and testified that the two were looking for patients who had locked themselves in toilets and a ward.

Uledhar's statement corroborated Kasab's confession that they tried to open the rooms of the ward in which patients were hiding, but did not succeed. "This is indicative of Kasab's warped mental attitude. He had no qualms about killing patients admitted in hospital," the judges said.
