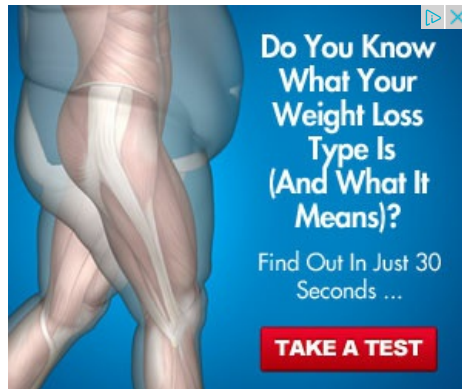

The two terrorists who went to the Taj Mahal hotel after the shootout at Leopold's café were seen "coolly walking" on the 23 ANF road shooting at anyone they saw. They killed at least two people-Subhash Waghela, 40, and Shamsuddin Khan, 55 who lived and worked in the area and left three others injured. Arun Shetty, a restaurateur, was near the entrance of his hotel with the owner when heard some sounds at about 9:30 pm "which sounded like fire crackers".When they heard the grenade exploding at Leopold's, Shetty lowered the shutters.

"That's when I saw two waiters away from Leopold. While one died right in front of the hotel, the other fell a littel further," said Shetty.

Vrandavan employee, Mohammed Ansari who was shot in the shoulder is now recovering at JJ hospital. The terrorists also shot at a tailor in the area and the owner of stall that sells snacks. Some cops who came from behind them were also shot at. "All this was over in five minutes," said Shetty. Police later found that that the blueberry muffin bag was filled with 30-35 kilos of magazine.
