Bizarre testimony: Okara school teacher claims Ajmal Kasab is alive

Teacher claims that he had met Kasab two days ago.

RAWALPINDI: Okara school teacher Mohammad Mudassar, who taught in the school where Ajmal Kasab studied, has made the rather bizarre claim that Kasab is alive and well in Pakistan, *Express News* reported.

Kasab, the only perpetrator from the 2008 Mumbai attacks to be captured alive, was hanged early morning on November 21, 2012 in Pune.

Mudassar made the claim of Kasab being alive during the hearing of the Mumbai attacks case in the Anti-Terrorism Court (ATC) in Rawalpindi. He had appeared in the hearing as a government witness.

Mudassar also presented an attendance register to support his claim that he had taught and knew Kasab.

Mudassar claims that he had met Kasab two days prior and that he is able to present Kasab in court.
